Teamwork from a distance

Live and life-size

The adjustable solution ranges from small customer meetings of up to 4 people to large conferences with up to 12 participants. Business partners can join the conference live on high-resolution, 65-inch TFT monitors (resolution 720p or 1080p) as if they were actually sitting there at the table in person. Additional high-definition cameras and a 4-channel sound system (full-duplex) with echo suppression create a real conference atmosphere. When a participant moves, his voice shifts accordingly – in CD quality. The attractive and practical conference table is equipped with power outlets

and Ethernet ports in each table leg, so that power and network jacks are available during the conference at all times.

Join in with the push of a button

Telepresence systems can be seamlessly integrated into corporate groupware such as MS Exchange. With Outlook, room and teleconferences can be just as easily scheduled as other calendar appointments. At the time of the conference, the Cisco Presence Manager transfers this information onto the display of the IP telephone in the conference room. Using this phone, participants can establish the video connection with just the push of a button. The Cisco Unified IP Telephone (series 7900) optimally supports users as they plan and conduct video conferences.
